Rules and Regulations: Solos and Bands

1. All events are conducted under the competition rules of the B.C. Pipers' Association www.bcpipers.org
2. The Beginner on practice chanter and Beginner on practice pad events are open to anyone who has played in the Beginner grade for less than 12 months and has not competed on the pipes or drums in solo competition.
3. Order of play for individual events is first to enter, last to play. Draw for the pipe band contests will be conducted the day after entries close at the Competition Secretary's address.
4. Orders of play will be posted on BCPA website one week before the Games.
5. Competitors and bands are responsible for checking in with the event's steward prior to the event. Competitors not ready to play in the posted order, may be disqualified at the discretion of the Steward for the event.
6. General gate opens at 7:30 am. Competitor numbers will be available at the Piping and Drumming Registration table commencing at 8:00 am. Events start sharp at 8:30 am.
7. Competitors must appear in acceptable and properly worn highland dress. Kilt (or trewes), shirt, hose and shoes are the minimum requirement. For beginners, dress pants, shirt and shoes (for boys or girls) & skirt, blouse & shoes (for girls) are acceptable.
8. Pipe Bands may challenge up one grade only if indicated at time of entry and if time permits. Bands desiring to challenge up must enter for all the band events in their regular grade and the event(s) they are challenging up. Prize money for only one grade will be awarded (whichever is highest).
9. Bands must play in Massed Bands at the end of the day to receive awarded prize monies.
10. Submitted entry fees are non-refundable. No late entries accepted.
